LIVE EXPORT OF HORSES FOR SLAUGHTER!

THIS SINISTER PRACTICE MUST END!

Every year, Canada ships thousands of draft horses to Japan and South Korea to be slaughtered for basashi. Two to four horses are loaded into each wooden crate smaller than a single horse stall to be flown over the ocean to their deaths. They are without food, water or rest for at least 28 hours, some arriving at their destination injured or dead. Subjected to painful branding and often morbidly obese and lame, these gentle giants must then endure this extreme confinement only to reach a tragic end.

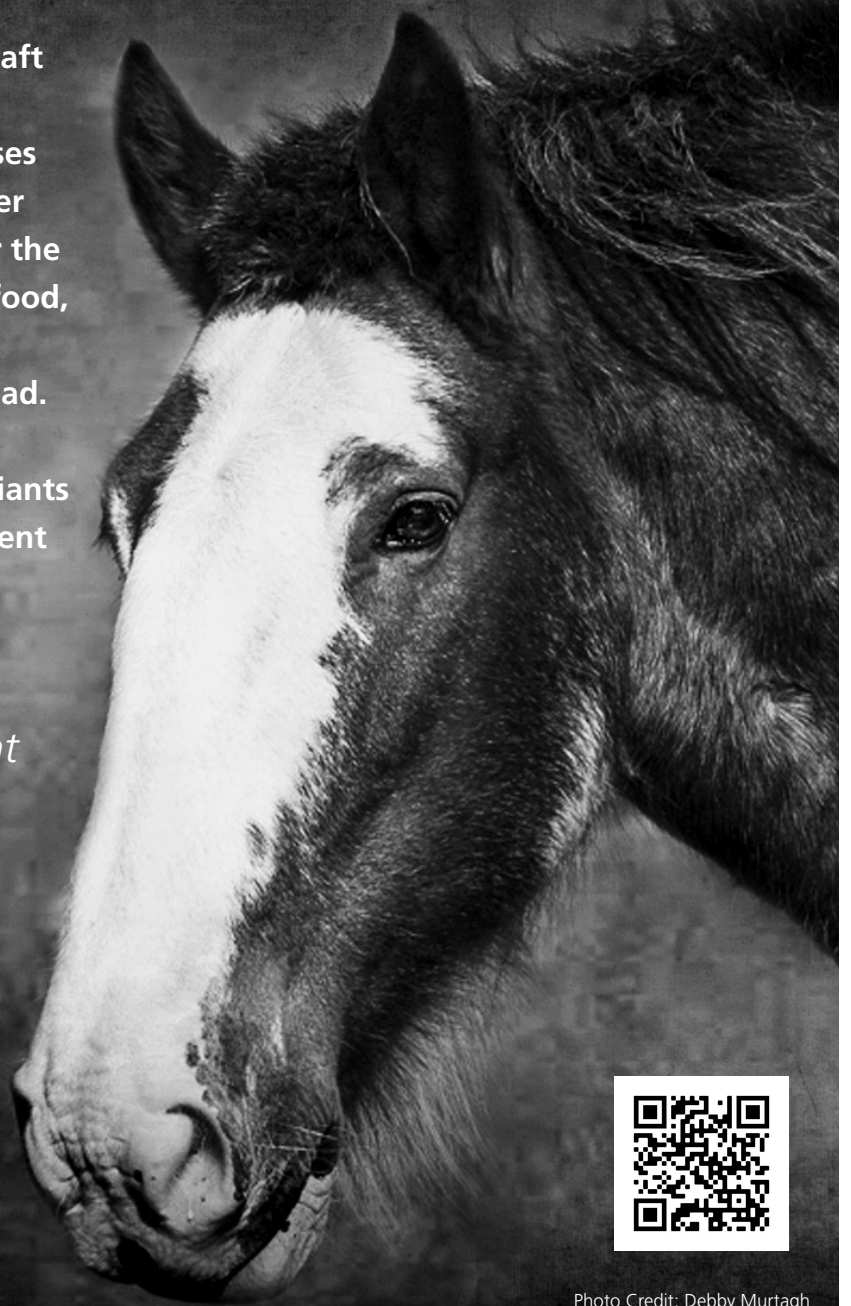
